

Tips on Modifying your Start Menu and/or Startup

*Note: Start Menu – modifying your menu (adding/deleting items).
Startup shows the programs that automatically run each time you turn on your PC (adding/deleting items).*

Windows 95 Operating system

- 1 **Start Menu** -- Go to Windows Explorer
- 2 C:\Windows\Start Menu\Programs – you can add or remove programs here

- 1 **Startup** -- C:\Windows\Start Menu\Programs\Startup folder - you can add or remove programs here for Startup
- 2 **OR** you can right-click on an open area of the taskbar and point to **Properties**. Then click the **Start Menu Programs tab** and add or remove items here.

Windows 98 Operating System

- 1 **Start Menu** -- Go to Windows Explorer
- 2 C:\Windows\Start Menu\Programs – you can add or remove programs here

- 1 **Startup** -- Go to **Start|Programs|Accessories|System Tools|System Information**
- 2 Select **Tools|System Configuration**
- 3 Click the **Startup tab** in the Dialog box
- 4 Select the programs you want to load at startup

Windows NT

- 1 **Start Menu/Startup** -- Right click on **Start button**
- 2 Click on **Explore All Users** or **Open All Users**
- 3 Explore All Users takes you into Windows Explorer to the exact place your startup menu is in your personal profile i.e. C:\Winnt\Profiles\All Users\Start Menu\Programs etc...
- 4 Can add, remove or move programs here for your Start Menu or Startup
- 5 *Note:* Might need to check individual user for those programs set specifically to that userid. *Check also* C:\Winnt\Profiles\trudep(userid)\Start Menu\Programs for additional programs.

- 6 **OR** Right click on an open area of the taskbar and point to **Properties**. Click on **Start Menu Programs tab**. Customize your start menu by using Add, Remove, or Advanced

Windows 2000

- 1 **Start Menu/Startup** -- Right click on **Start** button
- 2 Click on *Explore All Users* or *Open All Users*
- 3 Explore All Users takes you into Windows Explorer to the exact place your startup menu is in your personal profile i.e. C:\Winnt\Profiles\All Users\Start Menu\Programs etc...
- 4 Can add, remove or move programs here for your start menu or startup
- 5 Note: Might need to check individual user for those programs set specifically to that userid. *Check also* C:\Winnt\Profiles\trudep(userid)\Start Menu\Programs for additional programs.
- 6 **OR** Right click on an open area of the taskbar and point to **Properties**. Click on *Advanced tab*. Customize your start menu by using Add, Remove, or Advanced

Windows ME should be similar to 2000
