

What is WinZip?

Background and common questions:

What is WinZip?

WinZip is a program that “archives” files (it stores and distributes files by compressing them to save space). By compressing files it saves time and disk space.

What do I need this for?

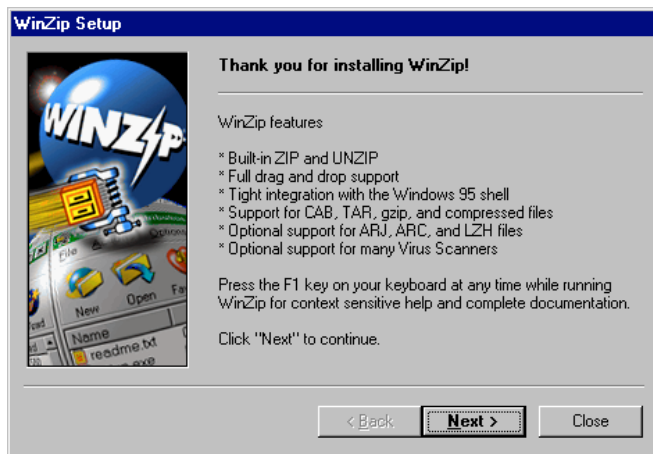
WinZip allows you to back up and restore your files quickly and efficiently. The file compression uses less space. Many times you will only need one diskette, instead of 3 or 5.

Installing WinZip

- 1) Put MarTech Systems Product CD in drive and let CD start up to the Main Menu. Or use **Start|Run** to open CD drive:\setup.exe.
- 2) Click on **Browse CD Contents**
- 3) Double-click on **Extras** folder
- 4) Double-click on **winzip70.exe**
Follow along to install:
 - WinZip 7.0- setup box -- Choose **Setup**
 - WinZip setup box – Click **OK** unless you want to create your own path.
 - WinZip setup box – Click **Next**.



- License and agreement – Click **Yes**.
 - Select WinZip “*classic*” – Click **Next**.
 - Select express setup – Click **Next**.
 - Thank you box – **Finish**.
- 5) After install you will probably get a Tip of the Day and the Actual WinZip program (unregistered). Close out of everything.
 - 6) **Exit** out of CD.
